

In the book "When God Whispers Your Name" Christian author Max Lucado tells a story that came to him from a friend who heard it from a friend who heard it from who knows who. Seems a fellow is shopping at a commissary on a military base. He doesn't need much; just some coffee and a loaf of bread. He's standing in line at the checkout counter. Behind him is a woman with her cart full to overflowing with groceries, clothing – even a VCR.

When the man's turn comes, he steps up to the register. The clerk invites him to pull a piece of paper out of a fishbowl, saying, "If you pull out the correct slip, then your entire purchase is free."

"How many 'correct slips' are there?" asks the buyer.

"Only one," she replies. The bowl is so full the chances are slim, but the fellow tries anyway; and wouldn't you know it, he gets the winning ticket! Then he realizes he is only buying coffee and bread. What a waste. But this fellow is quick. He turns to the lady behind him – the one with the cart full of stuff – and proclaims, "Look at this, Honey! We won! We don't have to pay a penny!"

She stares at him uncertainly. He waves the slip and winks at her. And somehow, she has the presence of mind to play along. She steps up beside him, puts his arm through his and smiles. And for a moment they stand side by side, wedded in good fortune. In the parking lot she crowns their temporary union by giving him a big hug, and goes on her way with a grand story to tell her friends.

I know, I know. What they did was a bit shady. He shouldn't have lied, and she shouldn't have pretended. But it's still a wonderful story. And it's a story not too distant from our own. We, too, have been given an unexpected gift – a gift even greater than that received by the woman in the commissary. Though her debt would have been great, she could pay it. We can't begin to pay ours.

We, like that woman, have had our debt marked "Paid in Full." Not at the checkout counter, but at the judgment seat of God, through the mercy of Christ. May this wonderful truth fill your heart and lift your spirits, today and every day . . . and don't forget to share this grand story with your friends!

Approved Motions – February 11, 2015, Session Meeting:

- The minutes of the regular Session Meeting of 12 Jan 2015.
- The ordination and installation of Linda Christian to the office of Deacon for a three year term.

- The Financial Secretary's report for the period ending 31 Jan 2015 and the following Treasurer's reports: Checking Account Summary, Year-to-Date Budget & January 2015 Financial Report.
- The transfer of \$4,500.00 from the Horizon investment account into the current fund (checking account).
- All expenditures over \$25 except salaries, utilities, taxes, snow removal, copier maintenance and custodial supplies (with a \$100 per month limit) must be approved by Session.
- Received minutes of the Christian Education Ministry Team meeting of 26 Jan 2015, the Congregational Life and Worship Ministry Team meeting of 9 Feb 2015, and the Trustees meeting of 2 Feb 2015.

- Accepted, with deep regret, resignations from membership from John and Vicki Henderson, Richard and Cheryn Mortimer, and Joe and Amy Tatarek. No letters of transfer were requested.
- Set the quorum for the ministry team and committee meetings, as the moderator plus two other team members.
- Pastor Sue's request for Study Leave for Mediation Skills Training from 11 through 17 May 2015.
- A request from the Franklin Women's AA Group for use of Moorhead Hall on Wednesday evenings, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., on a donation basis, to start on a date to be determined by them.
