Approved Motions – June 15, 2015 Session Meeting:

- The minutes of the regular Session Meeting of May 11, 2015.
- Wayne Edmondson's resignation from Session effective June 16, 2015, with thanks and appreciation of service.
- Financial Reports from Financial Secretary and Treasurer.
- Ministry teams' and Trustees' minutes as well as Administrative Activity Report.
- The resignation of Jim Clinefelter as Financial Secretary and Sheryl Clinefelter as Deacon.
- The consideration of a person who has previously served as an Elder; thus, no need to train.
- The election of Joyce Wetjen as Financial Secretary and Lois Pierce as Assistant Financial Secretary.
