

Operation Christmas Child: Five (5) shoeboxes for the ministry of Samaritan's Purse were collected during November and sent for distribution worldwide. Thanks to those who participated. That's five more children who have a chance to feel the love & prayers sent with the boxes and, hopefully, come to know Jesus in a personal way.

In order to have more boxes to send to Samaritan's Purse in 2016, we are changing the process of the program. The Missions & Outreach committee is assuming this project and making it a year-round ministry. Each month, beginning in January and ending in September, items will be requested for the boxes. In October, shoe boxes (cardboard or plastic) and cash to cover the \$7 per box will be requested; and, in November we will have a shoebox packing party after a luncheon on a Sunday afternoon. (The football season will determine which Sunday of course.) So, prepare for the first items for collection in January – small stuffed animals. A box will be in the narthex for collection.

FROM THE SESSION

Approved Motions from the Session Meeting – November 16, 2015:

- The minutes of the Session Meeting of October 19, 2015
- The October financial reports of the Financial Secretary and Treasurer
- The minutes of the Board of Trustees, Missions & Outreach Ministry Team and Congregational Life & Worship Committee
- The Report of Administrative Activity since last Session meeting
- The change to the Administrative Manual to allow two consecutive three-year terms for the office of Elder, Deacon and Trustee followed by one year off before that person may be elected to the same office
- The payment in full of the 2015 Per Capita \$3,746.50 (less payments made by members)
- The rejection of the offer from Bluehost (web site provider) to renew now at the current rate (going up 12/1/15) rather than waiting until June 2017.
- The approval to purchase a laser color all-in-one for the price of up to \$600 to be paid from Zeiler Memorial Funds of \$393.72 and the remainder from the General Fund.

NOTE: There will be no Session meeting in December. The next meeting will be January 18, 2016.

The Three Wise Women


