

FROM THE SESSION

Actions and Approved Motions – April 18, 2016, Session Meeting:

- Approved minutes of the March 21, 2016 Session Meeting and the April 3, 2016, Congregational Meeting
- Accepted the Financial Secretary's reports for the period ending March 31, 2016 and the Treasurer's reports for March, including the checking account summary, the budget year-to-date figures and the Financial Report of church accounts
- Received the minutes of the Congregational Life and Worship, Missions and Outreach, Christian Education, and Stewardship Ministry Teams as well as those of the Trustees meeting and report of Administrative Activity since the last Session meeting
- Approved the renewal of the *Domain Registration* for an additional year to June 11, 2017 at \$14.99.
- Received and approved the recommendation to close the Siefer Memorial Scholarship Account and distribute the proceeds equally among this year's applicants. The balance in the fund is \$1,828.
- Received and approved the recommendation to sell 200 shares of Energy Transfer Partners, LP in the Moorhead Scholarship Fund and invest the proceeds in Capital Income Builder in same fund.
- Received and approved the recommendation to increase Moorhead Scholarship disbursement to educational institutions of qualified applicants from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per recipient.
- Approved a motion to reimburse Diane Whitman up to \$50 for the purchase of a Bible for Reagan Hartman who will be graduating from Rocky Grove High School this year.
