

COOK'S CORNER

The following are some of the treats that Lois Pierce provided for Youthful Spirits luncheon on January 4th. She was asked to share them with the group. We thought it would be nice to give them to the congregation. Try them and enjoy!

APPLE DUMPLINGS

2 containers of Crescent Rolls

2 large apples, pared and cut into 8 slices each

Put apple slices in crescent rolls, roll up & place in a 9x13 pan.

Melt 2 sticks butter & add:

1 ½ cups sugar

1 tsp. Cinnamon

1 - 12 oz. can Ginger Ale (1 2/3 cups)

Pour over apples and bake in a 350 degree oven for 45 minutes. (I use a larger dish and 3 containers of crescent rolls, but use only one recipe of sauce, as very sweet otherwise.)

CRANBERRY SALAD

1 lg. or 2 sm. pkgs. Raspberry Jello 1 can whole cranberry sauce

2 cups boiling water 1 cup diced celery 1 cup cold water 1/2 cup chopped nuts

2 Tbsp. lemon juice

Mix together and put in a 9x13 dish.

WARREN QUILT SHOP COOKIES

1-14 oz. can condensed milk 1 cup chopped nuts 1 cup finely chopped dates Ritz crackers

Cook milk and dates 20 to 25 minutes in double boiler, stirring often. Keep stirring, add nuts. Spread on the crackers & put them on a cookie sheet. Bake 8 minutes in a 350 degree oven. Let cool and frost. Makes 7 doz. and may be frozen.

FROSTING:

4 oz. cream cheese ½ tsp. vanilla

¹/₄ cup oleo 2 cups confectioner sugar Blend cream cheese with oleo, then add vanilla and sugar.
