

There were 3,064 CWS Blankets distributed in 2016 worldwide where needed. Once again the Missions Ministry Team is asking for your help with donations for Church World Service Blanket Sunday on Sunday, June 18, 2017. It's Father's Day and we have chosen that day to "Blanket the World with Love from RGAPC"! These blankets help make it easier for many people to make it through another day and night.
