FROM THE SESSION

ACTIONS OF SESSION - NOVEMBER 13, 2017

- 1. Approved the minutes of the October 9, 2017 Session meeting.
- 2. Approved the Financial Secretary's Report ending October 31, 2017, and the checking account summary and Treasurer's Report for October. 2017.
- 3. Approved actions of church secretary in giving keys to various church buildings to Stephen and Beth West of Grace Learning Center and Wally Fox for emergency entry.
- 4. Approved the removal of the name of Don Fox from the active roll of the church.
- 5. Terminated members from the active roll of the church who have been inactive for at least two years and who have not responded to the letter sent out previously.
- 6. Approved a motion to divide the costs of the improvements made thus far to the church required under state safety laws with Grace Learning Center once they receive their funding.
- 7. Approved the 2018 budget to be presented to the congregation at the Annual Congregational and Corporation meetings to be held on November 19, 2017.
- 8. Approved a motion that no furnishings to be sold, transferred or disposed of shall be removed from the church property after midnight, November 13, 2017, without the approval of Session.



For Samaritan's Purse's "Operation Christmas Child" we collected enough to pack thirty-six (36) shoeboxes, which were prayed over during worship on November 19th and delivered for distribution throughout the world. Thanks to all who donated in any way to this worthy cause of outreach and demonstration of God's love. The necessary postage of \$324 was achieved through donations plus \$81 additional which will be donated to Samaritan's Purse. We will be continuing the program again in 2018 so get ready for January with hats, gloves & scarves.

The Annual Meetings of the Congregation & Corporation were held Sunday, November 19th in the sanctuary. Rev. Rachel Johns opened the meetings with prayer. Twenty members were in attendance and represented a quorum. Elders elected for 2018 are: Linda Hartman (4th year), Lois Pierce (6th year), Diane Whitman (4th year) and Linda Zeller (4th year) for another 1-year term. There are 3 vacancies of 3-year terms and 1 vacancy of 2-year terms. Deacons elected are: Judy Ream (3-year terms) as well as **Doris Feather** (6th year) and **Phyllis Vogan** (5th year) remaining for 1-year terms. There are 3 vacancies -2 for 3-year terms and 2 for 2-year terms. Trustees elected for 1-year additional term are: Arnie Bish (7th year) and Kevin Songer (4th year). There are 5 vacancies - 1 each for 1-year and 2-year terms and 3 for 3-year term. Auditor: Lois Pierce Presbyterian Home Reps: Jim & Flo Albright and Gene & Marge Sheffer. Johns. John Dumbleton, moderator of Trustees, gave a report of work performed in the past year and what is planned for 2018. He thanked Scott Donaldson and Rhonda Rust for their service as volunteer trustees and the donors of funds for the work done to remove the back of the building and make improvements to the drainage system.

Please give generously to this worthy cause. You will find special envelopes in the pews. If you are writing a check, please write "Christmas Joy" on the memo line.


