### FROM THE SESSION

ACTIONS OF SESSION – DECEMBER 11, 2017

- 1. Approved the minutes of the November 13, 2017 Session meeting.
- 2. Approved the Financial Secretary's Report ending November 30, 2017, and the checking account summary and Treasurer's Report for November, 2017.
- 3. Authorized the Church Treasurer to sell such investments as necessary on the advice of our Edward Jones financial advisor to meet the year-end and year-beginning finances, bring the balance of the checking account to \$5,000 minimum to avoid bank fees, and continue to move the dividends into the checking account to pay current expenses until June 30, 2018 as necessary.

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
