FROM THE SESSION

ACTIONS OF SESSION - MAY 14, 2018

- 1. Approved the minutes of the April 9, 2018 Session meeting.
- 2. Approved the Financial Secretary's Report ending March 31, 2018, the checking account summary and Treasurer's Report for March, 2018.
- 3. Approved a request to sell the old mower and dispose of the old computer.
- 4. Appointed a committee consisting of Linda Hartman, Diane Whitman, and Rhonda Rust to go through the kitchen cupboards and decide what items will be disposed of and how that will be done.
- 5. Approved a motion allowing the Trustees to determine what items in the garage may be disposed of, given away or sold. If any member of the Church is interested, talk to a Trustee within the next week. Deadline is May 29.
- 6. Approved a motion to apply to First National Bank for a credit card with a maximum amount of \$2,000 with Lois Pierce and Rhonda Rust being the approved signatories.
- 7. Approved a motion to forgive July and August rent, 2018 only, for Grace Learning Center provided March, April, May and June rent is placed in escrow with their attorney, George Thompson, until the lease can be signed. Because GLC could not open at the beginning of the school year due to state's delay in inspecting the premises and the last-minute requirement that all GLC board members go through clearances, the center has not been fully funded for the 2018-2019 school year.
- 8. Approved the purchase of a Bible for Austin Clark.
- 9. Removed from the Membership Roll the name of Mabel Mong, Member No. 1638, who passed away on April 25, 2018.
- 10. Approved the donation of \$100 to the Rocky Grove Volunteer Fire Department.
- 11. Approved the request of the Church Secretary to change her work hours during the summer months to begin and end a half -hour earlier than her usual hours.
