FROM THE SESSION

ACTIONS OF SESSION – AUGUST 13, 2018:

- 1. Approved the minutes of the June 11 and July 9, 2018 Session meetings.
- 2. Approved the Financial Secretary's Report ending July 31, 2018, the checking account summary and Treasurer's Report for July, 2018.
- 3. Ratified the phone conference of Session members authorizing the monthly transfer of funds from the Horizon Account to the First National Bank checking account to pay current expenses until the end of December, 2018.
- 4. Voted to release the \$660 technology grant from Presbytery to be used by another entity. It appears the Church does not need any technological upgrades at this time.
- 5. Approved a motion to allow "Friends in Motion," a line-dancing group, to use Moorhead Hall on Mondays from Labor Day through Memorial Day. After the custodian's fees are paid by the group, any remaining donations will be given to the Church.
- 6. Approved a motion to spend up to \$1,000 to purchase, deliver, install a new refrigerator in the kitchen in Moorhead Hall and have the old one removed.
- 7. Approved a motion to dispose of the old piano in Moorhead Hall since there does not seem to be any interest in it. This was done with heavy hearts.

2018 PER CAPITA

Now that half of the year has come and gone, the Presbytery office has sent us a friendly reminder concerning per capita. Your payments make a difference as the Presbytery of Lake Erie seeks to work together to build the Kingdom of God. The per capita amount per member is \$31.00 (\$20.97 goes to Presbytery of Lake Erie, \$2.30 goes to Synod and \$7.73 goes to General Assembly).
