If you are not able to go shopping but would like to give a monetary donation for these gifts, please see a member of the Missions Ministry Team. Thank you very much!


Please be aware that *Christmas Joy Offering* will be received during Advent, December 2<sup>nd</sup> through Christmas Eve, again this year.
