July received its name in order to honor the Roman dictator Julius Caesar (100 B.C.–44 B.C.).

July 1 is **Canada Day**, a Canadian holiday that celebrates the creation of the Dominion of Canada in 1867. The Dominion of Canada was a union of the three separate Canadian colonies of the time—New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Canada (which included Quebec and Ontario). Canada remained a part of the British Empire until 1982.

- July 4: Independence Day (U.S.) on the fourth of July celebrates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence in 1776. Don't forget to raise the flag!
